



Notice of Race

Nottinghamshire County Sailing Club

Spring Regatta

Saturday 27th May to Monday 29th May 2017

Racing will be held under the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, The Open Meeting Sailing Instructions of NCSC, and the principals and practices of the RYA Racing Charter.

Entry fee structure:

Adult 3-Day -	£30.00
Junior (<19) 3-Day -	£15.00
Adult 1-Day -	£15.00
Junior (<19) 1-Day -	£10.00

Entries will be allowed until Thursday 25th May, there is a limit to maximum numbers.

An event briefing will be held at 11.00 on Saturday 27th May in the area of the Race Office.

Race series planned, the first start NOT before 1130 on Saturday 27th May:

Commodore's Cup, Category Racing, Regatta Cup and Junior Race - Three Races are intended, if three races are held the worst score will be discarded.

Team Racing – Format to be defined at the event briefing.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 RRS. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

Clarification as to Competitions

Regatta Cup

This is open to Novice Helms (defined as not winning a club or class trophy) and will be determined by the Race Officer and Vice Commodore in the event of uncertainty

Junior entrants are defined by the oldest sailor in the boat

Three races are planned

Commodore Cup

The split between the Fast and Slow fleet will be determined by the number of entrants and will be made to try to define two approximately equal fleets. There will be sailboard, fast, slow and junior starts

Category racing

The competition will be divided into sailboard double handed, single handed, and junior fleets. If there are sufficient entries the double-handed entries will be further divided into non-spinaker, asymmetric spinnaker and symmetric spinnaker boats.

All participants should be listed through the entry process – visiting sailors need to complete an entry form, their representative should pay the entry fee and sign the entry form to conform that their craft is insured for third party liability to a minimum of £2,000,000.

Published race times are subject to change and any variation will be posted on the chalk board near the Race Office.

Prizes will be awarded depending on the number of entries.

Each entrant is to carry a pair of Allen Bros stickers to the port & starboard sides of their craft's bow or, if they have a hull finish that will be damaged by stickers, to either side of the mainsail boom or to the points inside the cockpit along the top of the port & starboard tank-sides where the stickers will not be obscured by the crew in their usual positions

Competitors are able to camp at the sailing club from Friday 27th May. Access to the club requires a visitor security code, if you are intending to come to this event please contact the organisers via the website or via springregatta@ncsc.org.uk.
