



Notice of Race

The event will be run under the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020, the Scorpion Class Association rules and the Open Meeting Sailing Instructions of N.C.S.C.

Any changes to the Open Meeting Sailing Instructions will be displayed at the Race Office.

Start times:

Saturday 13 October 1st Race - no earlier than 12.00hrs

Times of further races will be displayed at the Race Office and may be held back to back.

Sunday 14 October 1st Race – no earlier than 10:00hrs

Times of further races will be displayed at the Race Office and may be held back to back.

Scoring: The Low Points Scoring System will be used for all racing.

Race Format

All boats will race together.

If 6 races are held: 2 discards.

If 5 races are held: 1 discard.

4 or less races all scores to count.

Entries:

The safety of the boat and her entire management, including insurance, shall be the sole responsibility of the owner or helm of the boat. They must ensure that the boat and crew are adequate to face the conditions that may arise in the course of the race. Neither the Sailing Instructions nor any inspection of the boat limits or reduces the absolute responsibility of the owner/helm for the crew, the boat and her management.

The race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, howsoever caused, to the owner/helm or crew, as a result of taking part in the race or races. Every owner/helm warrants the suitability of the boat for the race or races.

Entry Fees:

£30.00 per boat, except junior combinations £20.00

Open Meeting Sailing Instructions are available on the web-site and will be available at the event from 9.30am Saturday 13.10.2018.

Prizes will be awarded to the first 3 boats; flyer of the day Saturday and Sunday; Junior and perhaps the odd spot prize as the eccentric choice of the commodore is minded.
