Amendment to NCSC Open Meeting SIs

The Open Meeting Sailing Instructions are amended as follows:

5 SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1 On Saturday 13th October it is intended that there will be between 4 and 6 races of short duration. The start of the first race will be no earlier than 1200. Depending on circumstances, there may be a break after 2 or 3 races.

5.2 On Sunday 14th October it is intended to run three races back to back with an intended race duration for the leading boat of 40 minutes. The start of the first of these races will be no earlier than 1000.

5.3 On Sunday 14th October, no warning signal will be given after 1300.

8 COURSE

8.3 Depending on circumstances, there will be a lead boat for the first lap of any race that follows a change of course. The presence of a lead boat is intended as a guide and it is the competitors' responsibility to sail the correct course. If the lead boat makes a mistake, this will not be accepted as grounds for redress under Rule 62.1(a).

10 THE START

10.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying a yellow triangle on the port side of the Committee Boat and a yellow outer distance mark.

12 TIME LIMITS

12.1 The race committee may hail boats sailing behind the main body of the fleet in order to offer them a finishing position without their needing to complete the race. Flag W may or may not also be used for this purpose. Competitors shall accept a position offered under these circumstances.

14 SCORING

14.2 There will be one discard allowed after four races have been completed and two discards after eight races.
