Course

Use a long course over the whole of the lake to minimise possibility of the leading boats lapping the slower boats.

Entries

Entrants are required to sign on legibly for the race using the sheet (see below) posted by the race team on the desk outside the Race Office. Junior and / or Youth sailors are permitted to start at appropriate time for their class within the Pursuit race. This now includes Topper 5.3 and Feva's. In this case they will sail the full race duration.

If one or more Junior and / or Youth sailors sign on for the Junior Handicap race they start at -9 minutes and have a suitable race length as determined by the Race Officer. Please create 2 distinct headings on the Signing on sheet for Juniors entering the Pursuit and Juniors entering the Handicap.

Please record all sail numbers of boats racing on the race results sheet (See below).

Start Time

Scheduled for 13.15. If later than that, display the proposed start time on the noticeboard and make an announcement.

The order of the Oakleaf and Frostbite races will be reversed on the final Sunday of the series i.e. the pursuit race first followed by the handicap race, and both races will be held back to back.

Accompany all above Timing points with one longer sound signal. Scroll the number board to display the corresponding countdown time starting at -15 and including -1. Note the Race timer is currently programmed to start at -12 and will not sound -1 minute. Please sound -15 and -1 manually. After 0 min make a short sound signal every 30 seconds and a longer sound signal every minute. Scroll the number board every minute.

The Hansa & Liberty Sailability class boats will start the Pursuit race at the first sound signal which is the -15 minute. Note that their handicaps do entitle them to start earlier than this.

Topper's taking part in the Pursuit will start on -9 and the Feva's at -1 minute.

If wind conditions are very strong or very light the pursuit start may be changed to handicap starts at the discretion of the Race Team. In these circumstances the start sequence will be as for the Oakleaf series; and the "Fast" and "Slow" handicap results will be scored as one fleet and will count as a race in the Pursuit race series. Junior and / or Youth sailors signed on for the Junior Handicap race should start at the Junior start and their scores will count toward the Junior Handicap. Scores of Junior and / or Youth Sailors signed on for the pursuit race will count toward the pursuit race series.

Individual recall

If those over the line can be identified - X flag up with one extra sound signal. Lower flag when recalled boats have returned and re-crossed the start line, or after 20 seconds.

General recall

If too many are over the line to identify them, General recall (First Substitute) flag up with two sound signals.

If any fleet is recalled, it starts 1 minute after its original start time.

Note: X & First Substitute flags are at each end of a pole stored on Triton

Finish

Duration: Windsurfers 30-40 minutes

Juniors 45-60 minutes Pursuit race 80 minutes

Windsurfer Race

After 35 to 40 minutes,

either open the finish line by raising the S flag and Windsurfer fleet flag on the committee boat with two sound signals. Every Windsurfer which crosses the finish line is then a finisher and should be given a short hoot on the horn.

or finish the first Windsurfer between a mark and a safety boat displaying the S flag and the Windsurfer fleet flag.

Record the number of laps and the finishing time of each Windsurfer.

Junior Race

After 45-60 minutes,

Follow a similar procedure as used for the Windsurfers but raising the Junior fleet Flag. (Record times for all Junior starters at -9 in case some fail to complete the Pursuit).

Pursuit

Anticipate where the leading boat will be at 80 minutes. Position Triton with one Safety boat (or a pair of Safety boats) to create a mobile finish line to intercept the leading boat at that point on the course. Display a blue flag on one boat. At 80 minutes exactly, sound one long hoot on the horn. Competing boats should hold position relative to one another after this signal.

The Safety boat's finish line then moves at pace along the course from the lead boat back through the fleet. The Race clerk, assisted by the APRO records the finishing order of all competitors until the last boat is reached.

Results

Amendments to entries and raw result sheets showing recorded times against sail numbers should be photographed and sent by email to the series Results Sec, Graham Young, at grahamyoung.3466@gmail.com. The Results Sec will calculate and publish the race results. The Race Officer should store the original sheets in the Results file in the Race Office.
