



# NCSC Dinghy Instructor Pathway - Adults

**RYA Advanced Module Ability Sailor**  
Seamanship, Sailing with Spinnakers, Day Sailing, Start Racing or Performance Sailing  
– An assessment day may be required



Assistant Instructor candidates will be required to spend 1 season helping as part of Saturday club / Stage 1/2/3 Courses (3 days minimum) and 2 days observing RYA Adult level 1 & 2 before being put forward for AI course – The course can cover Youth and/or Adult teaching.

**RYA Assistant Instructor - Teaching Adult Level 1 and 2 (Stratos)**

PB2 and 1<sup>st</sup> aid required.



After a minimum of 1 season (5 days) teaching and pre-assessment, AIs may be put forward for DI course
