Adult Sailing Course Application Form

About the Course

This course consists of the RYA Level 1, Start Sailing, and Level 2, Basic skills, which are combined so that by the end of the course should be able to helm a dinghy in good conditions. All the Courses are run by unpaid qualified volunteers. The course has both theory and practical elements. You will spend the majority of your time afloat in double-handed dinghies, sailing in a range of weather conditions. Initially you will sail with an instructor onboard but toward the end of the course you will sail without an instructor. Sailing is a physical activity and if you are in any doubt about your suitability to take part you should obtain medical advice

Course Booking terms

Risk assessment

- It must be recognised that sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the training course you agree and acknowledge that:
- You are aware that it is an outdoor activity with an element of risk. Participants should be prepared to be wet, and on occasions, cold and possibly be knocked or bruised.
- It is your responsibility to state if you have any medical condition which may affect your ability to participate in the course.
- At all times comply with the instructions given by instructors, particularly with regard to handling of boats, wearing of buoyancy aids and the wearing of suitable clothing for the conditions; and accept the responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by your own negligence.
- I understand that the club's instructors do not accept any responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to people or property arising out of, or during the course of, the instructors' activities while instructing unless such injury loss or damage was caused by, or resulted from negligence or deliberate act.
- At the start of the course, you will inform the organiser if there have been any changes to the information provided on this form.
- The provision of safety boat cover is limited to such assistance as can be practically provided in the circumstances;

2. Cancellation

- You understand the organiser may cancel or postpone the course at any stage in the event of bad weather, equipment failure or otherwise.
- A full refund will be given if a place on the course is cancelled 3 weeks or more before the start of the course. After that, any refund will be at the discretion of the training committee.

3. Misconduct

You understand that the organiser may exclude anyone from a particular session and ask anyone who refuses to comply with these course booking terms or who misconducts themselves in any way or who causes damage or annoyance to other persons to leave.
