NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1. Racing will be held under the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-2024, the Open Meeting Sailing Instructions of NCSC, and the principals and practices of the RYA Racing Charter.

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1. Please enter by completing an entry form online via the link below:

Please pay the relevant entry fee using the BACS details shown on the form

2.2. Online entries will close at 5pm, Friday 1st Oct 2021. Late entries will be accepted at the club on the race day.

3. Fees

3.1. Entry fees: Adults £20 per boat, Youth (under 21 as at 31st Dec 2021) £10 per boat

4. Schedule

4.1. A briefing will take place on the Club House balcony at 10.30am.

4.2. The 1st warning signal shall not be before 10.55am Saturday 2nd Oct 2021.

4.3. Maximum of up to 4 races to be sailed.

4.4. The last start will be no later than 1600 hours

4.5. One discard will be allowed if three or more races are sailed. If less than three races sailed overall, results of all sailed races will count.

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1. NCSC Open Meeting Sailing Instructions can be viewed on the club website

5.2. Amendments to the Sailing Instructions will be posted no later than 1 hour before the start of scheduled racing in a notice posted on the noticeboard.

5.3. The Notice Board is adjacent to the Race Office inside the conservatory.

6. Prizes

6.1. Prizes will be awarded for the first 3 places overall. The race committee may award prizes for other categories subject to entry numbers.

7. Disclaimer of Liability

7.1. Competitors participate in the event entirely at their own risk. See rule 4 RRS. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

8. Insurance

8.1. All participants shall be listed on the entry form, they or their representative shall pay the entry fee and sign the entry form to confirm that their craft is insured for third party liability to a minimum of £3 million.

9. Further information

9.1. Any COVID restrictions in force will be notified on the official notice board outside the clubhouse. In the event that National Legislation places a more onerous restriction on the public than National Legislation shall take precedence

9.2 Food will be available during the event, served in the clubhouse and consumed subject to COVID restrictions.

9.3 Free camping will be available from the night before the event until it finishes. All participants are reminded of their responsibilities to ensure they adhere to the current government COVID guidelines in place for the event.
