SUPPLEMENTARY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

To be read in conjunction with the RS Class Association Standard Sailing Instructions

5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at the flagpole on the club veranda.
- 5.2 The official notice board is outside the Race Office in the Clubhouse Conservatory
- 5.3 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 15 minutes' in Race Signals AP. This changes race signals AP.

7 CLASS FLAGS

RS400 RS400 Class Flag or if not available Numeral 1

9. COURSES

- 9.1 Courses to be sailed will be Windward Leeward or Trapezoid. The diagrams in Addendum A show the courses, the order in which marks are to be passed and the side on which each mark is to be passed
- 9.2 If the course to be sailed is Trapezoid, Flag T will be flown. If flag T is not flown the course will be Windward/Leeward.
- 9.3 The number of rounds to be sailed will be indicated on a board on the side of the committee boat.

10 MARKS

Mark	Description
1	Orange Cylindrical
2	Red/White/Blue Cylindrical (T)
3P	Black Pillar
3S	Black Pillar
4	Lime Green / Orange Cylindrical (A)
Outer Distance Mark	Yellow Hexagonal
Inner Distance Mark	Yellow Hexagonal

- 10.4 The windward leg gate shall be the line between the inner and outer distance marks.

11 OBSTRUCTIONS

12 The Start

12.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange shape on the committee boat at the starboard end and the course side of the Outer Distance Mark. An Inner Distance Mark may be used.

14 The Finish

The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an blue flag on the committee boat at the starboard end and the course side of the port end starting mark. An Inner Distance Mark may be used.

Marks 2P/2S are a gate
 The start finish line forms a gate on the windward leg only
 Mark 1 to be rounded to Port

Trapezoid

1 lap 1, 2, 3P/3S, 2,3P,4, Finish
 2laps 1, 2, 3P/3S, 2,3P, 4, G, 1, 2, 3P/3S, 2,3P,4, Finish
 3 laps 1, 2, 3P/3S, 2,3P,4, G, 1, 2, 3P/3S, 2,3P,4, G, 1, 2, 3P/3S, 2,3P,4, Finish

Marks 1, 2, 3P, 4 to be rounded to port
